 - O Class that can retain what they are taught, and review it so they can make the most of what they have learned.


■ What teachers aim for:


- O Hold rich sense of humanity and have unconditional care towards students.

PTA memembers have approved as the new PTA president and as well as the new PTA committee Thank you for your cooperation.


