



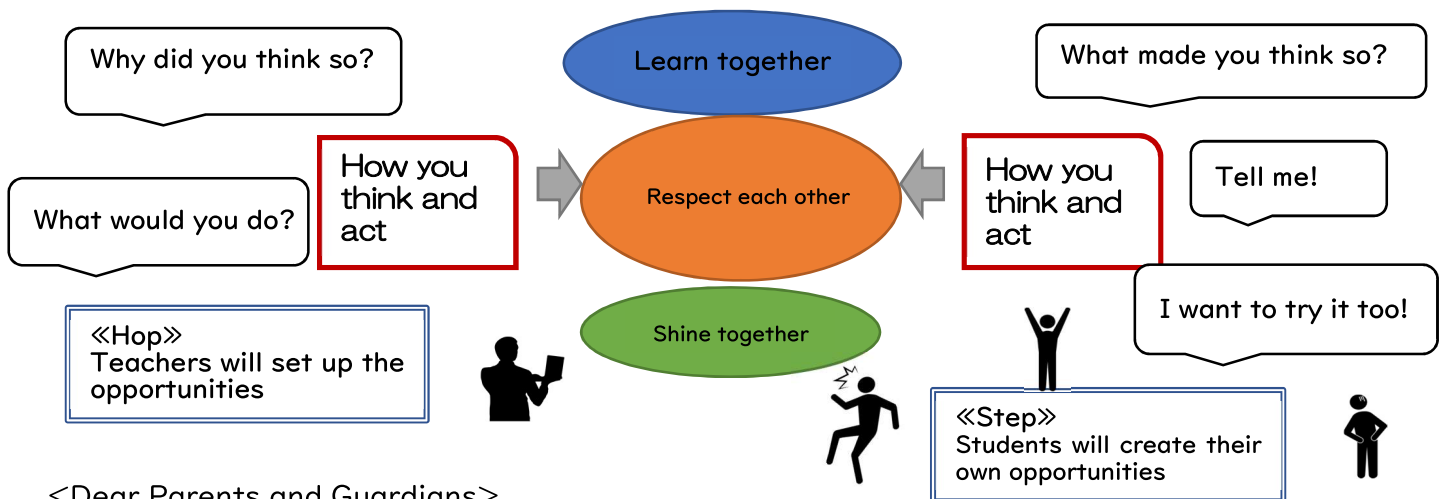
## Hop•Step•Jump
